Modified double elimination  
International Judo Federation rules with the following safety modifications:

- Arm locks permitted - Senior men and women only.
- Choking permitted - 13 years old and above.
- Golden score - 2 minutes for junior divisions and 3 minutes for senior divisions.
- Rest periods - Rest periods will not exceed the length of a match.

*Age and weight divisions are subject to change to ensure the safety of the participant. Coaches, Instructors, & Parents will have an opportunity to review the categories and confirm their child's/athletes suitability for participation. Boys and girls age ten and under may be asked to compete in a co-ed division.*
